2. Body of paper (TNR 14pt., bold)

The article must be divided into sections. *Introduction* and *conclusion* are obligatory. It is recommended to adjust body of the paper to the common organization structure of scientific papers –***Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion***.

3. Conclusion (Title TNR 14pt., bold)
