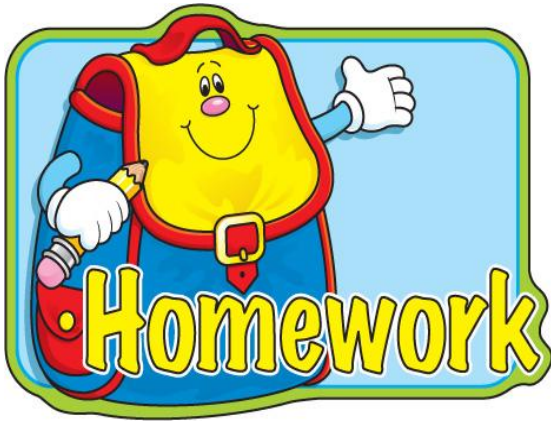
*Help me learn 3 new sentences everyday in English.*

**NOTE:** *All the written work to be done in the same notebooks being used in class.*

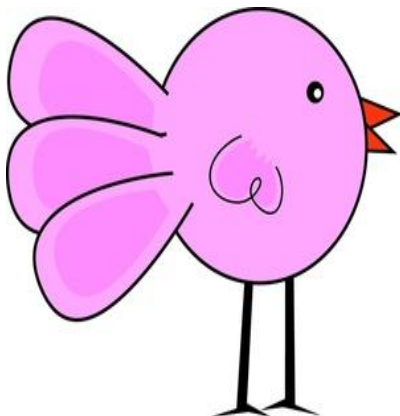
➤ **ENGLISH:** 1) Reading of Pg. No. 4 to 11 (using phonic sounds) from Pre-School Phonic Primer Reader.

➤ **MATHS:** 1) Counting 1-150 (4 times) 2) Dodging 1-150 (5 times)  
3) What comes after 1-150 (5 times)

4) **CONCEPTS:** Learn and draw the related pictures of concepts: empty-full, big-small, tall-short and up-down.
