Warm greetings!



### COMMUNICATION SKILLS

- Read a picture book with your child daily. This will enhance vocabulary and develop a love for books at an early age.
- Let your toddler recite a short and simple nursery rhyme with you. Let him/her learn it and then recite independently too.
- Place familiar objects in a box. Have your child take one out and tell you its name and how to use it. "This is my ball. I bounce it. I play with it."
- Ask questions that include a choice. "Do you want an apple or an orange?" "Do you want to wear your red shirt or your blue shirt?"

### SOCIAL SKILLS

- Celebrate a "Mama's help day". Let your child assist you in cleaning, dusting, cooking etc.
- Invite your child's friends over for a "Play date". Organize turn taking games. Have friends sit in a circle, and give a ball to your child. Then ask him/her to name someone in the circle and roll the ball to him or her.
- Celebrate a "Field Visit" day. Visit the local fruit/vegetable market, mall, park etc. with your child. Let your child interact with the people present there.
- Pretend play "Meal time". Let your toddler pass food at the table to other members and learn golden words "Please" and "Thank you".
- Let your child make a card for the grandparents and visit them. Their love and emotional support is very important for your child. Click snaps with them

## SELF MANAGEMENT SKILLS

- Give 2-3 water containers to your little one. Let him/her transfer water from one container to the other. This will enhance your child's motor skills.
- Let your child hit targets with a ball.
- Prepare a DIY (do it yourself) craft with your child to enhance fine motor skills.
- Help your child mould potter's clay (chikni mitti) or plain flour (atta) and be creative.
- Prepare "Busy Books" with and for your little one (as demonstrated by the class teacher).

## RESEARCH SKILLS

- Give some things to your child. Let him/her throw them in the water to see what floats/sinks.
- Watch the stars and clouds. If possible use a pair of binoculars.
- Let your child feed the birds and observe them eat.
- Visit the park. Collect some fallen leaves and let your child observe the differences.
- Let your child sow a seed, nurture the sapling and the plant by observing and watering it.

*Click pictures as your little one does these activities and paste them in a scrap book to create memories. Send the scrap to school after vacations.*

Last but not the least, try to keep your child away from TV, mobile phones, computers and other electronic gadgets; they have their whole life for that. Look into the eyes of your little one and thank God for giving you one - wonderful gift. In a few years from now, he/she will be soaring to great heights.
