
## 1. Place Value Puzzle

**1. Making a Herbarium** - A herbarium is a collection of dried and pressed plants or leaves. For hundreds of years scientists and plant lovers have preserved dried plants for study in herbariums to use the data associated with it for scientific study.



### **Instructions :**

- Collect ten leaves of different plants.
- Clean off any dirt or bugs from the plant.
- Dry all the leaves by placing them in between the pages of old newspaper/ old book.
- Set it aside for 8-10 days to let the leaves dry.
- Once the leaves are dry, you are ready to compile your herbarium pages.
- Using narrow pieces of tape, secure each leaf on an A4 size pastel sheet.
- Write the following details of each leaf
- a) Name of the plant.
- b) Does the plant have any nutritional or medicinal qualities?
- Compile all the pages and make a folder. Also decorate the folder.


